NAVASSA, NC – In December 2016, the Multistate Environmental Response Trust (Multistate Trust) acquired two residential properties, which were bounded on all sides by the former Kerr-McGee Navassa facility property.

The Multistate Trust acquired the properties because their location posed logistical and engineering challenges for site cleanup. The acquired properties were not impacted by site contamination.

The acquisition of the properties was supported by the U.S. Environmental Protection (EPA) and the North Carolina Department of Environmental Quality (NCDEQ), both of which approved the Multistate Trust's use of cleanup funds for the acquisition. Cleanup funds were provided by the companies responsible for the Site contamination.
