Draft Redevelopment Concepts

On Friday, February 23 and Saturday, February 24, 2018, a Community Visioning Workshop was held at the Navassa Community Center to help shape the future of the Kerr-McGee Chemical Corp -- Navassa Superfund Site (the Site). Approximately 50 people attended the first session on Friday evening, with more than 45 participating on Saturday the 24th. At the workshop, participants had the opportunity to learn about market research and the opportunities and constraints for the future development of the Site. In addition, members of the Redevelopment Working Group presented four preliminary redevelopment scenarios for the Site to kick off the Visioning Workshop on Friday. On Friday and Saturday, workshop attendees worked with planning team and Redevelopment Working Group members to create eleven additional development scenarios for the Site.

All of the 15 redevelopment scenarios were reviewed by the planning team and summarized into 4 potential redevelopment concepts that are displayed on the following pages. The planning team worked with the 15 scenarios to group similar ideas and themes in generating the potential concepts. The ideas and themes were communicated on the 15 scenario maps by meeting participants through a combination of the following:

- Arranging color-coded circular shapes on a map of the Site that represented the acreage and type of development/use;
- Writing notes on a map of the Site describing a scenario in greater detail;
- · Placing images from example development types on a map of the Site, and
- Presenting their group's scenarios at the meetings.
